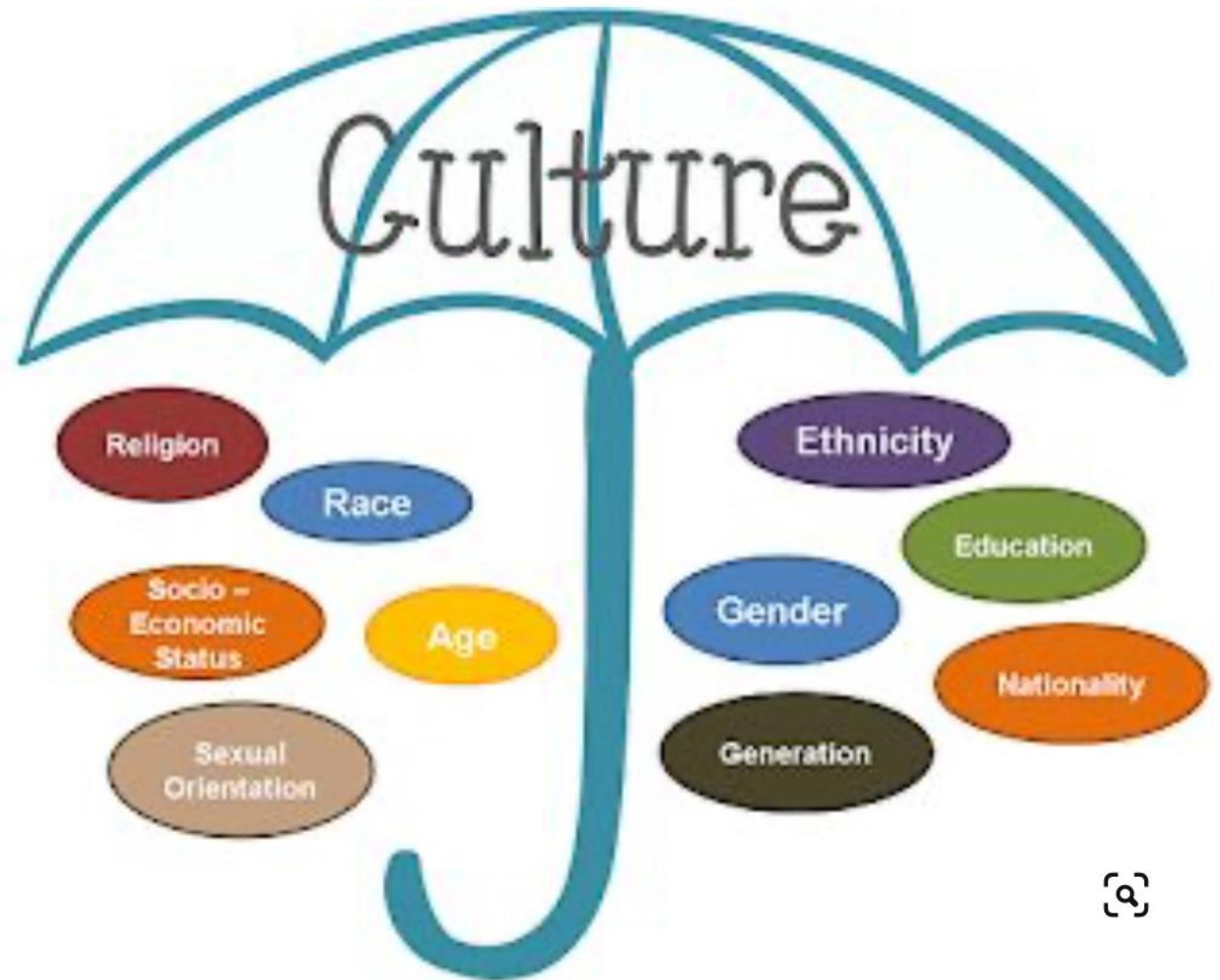
Cultural Studies

It is a field of study that examines how **social structures** are created.

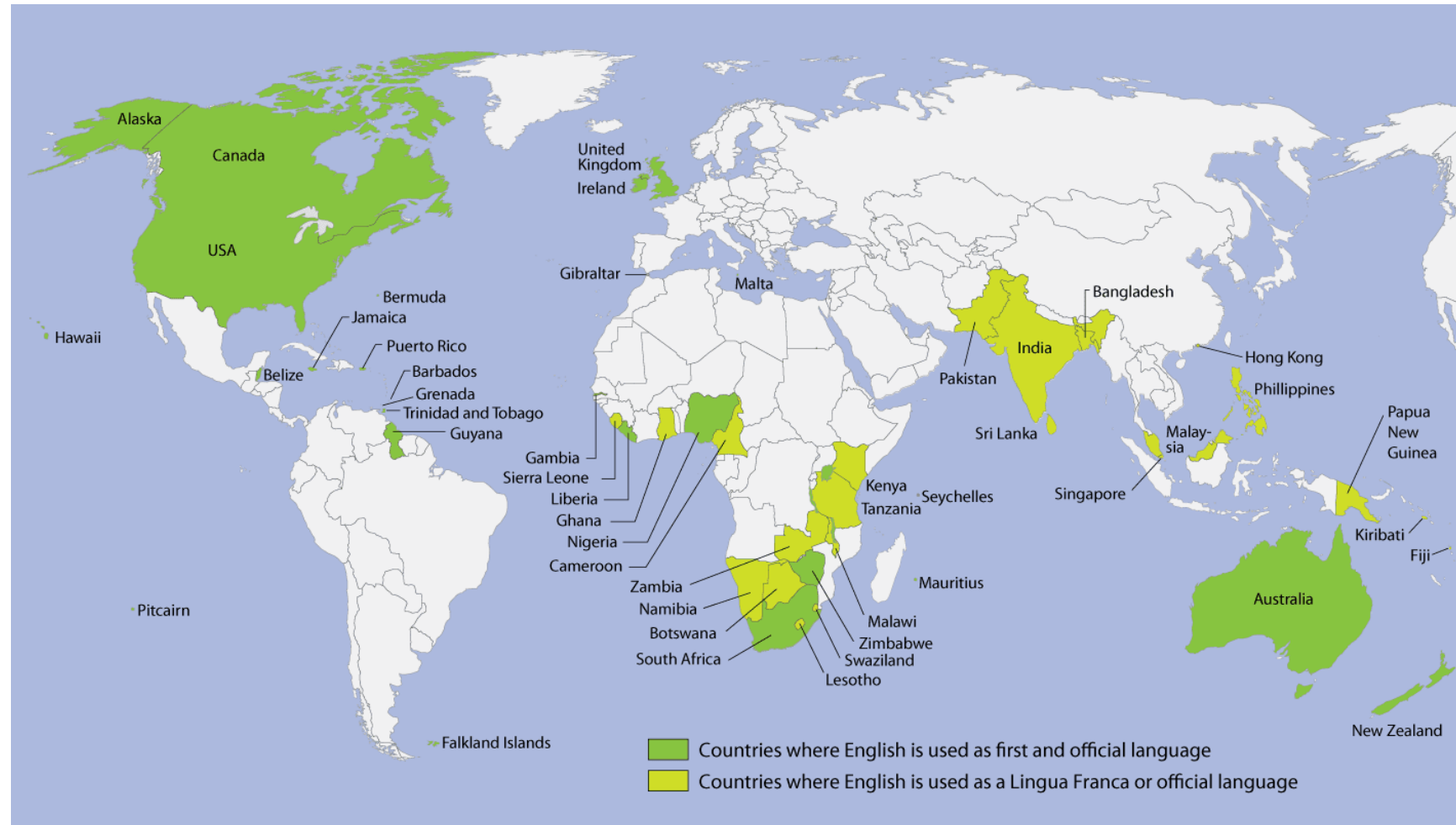
You work with film, social media, art, music, fashion, sport, everyday activities and many more.

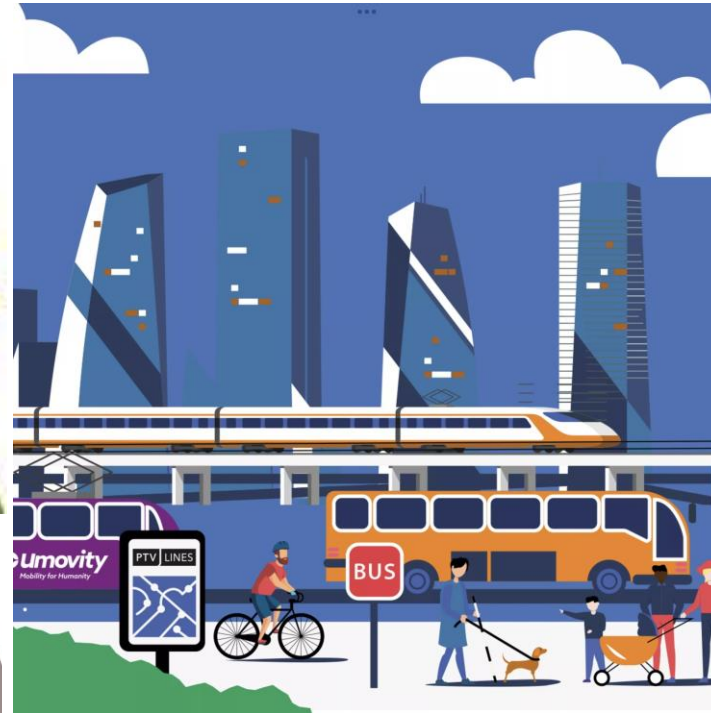
